

To be inserted into the Definitions:

1. **Standard Regulation Uniform** means:
 - (a) playing uniform which may include:
 - (i) a dress;
 - (ii) a top and skirt; and / or
 - (iii) a top and shorts;
 - (b) sports briefs (which may be in Club colours or plain black or navy); and
 - (c) playing position bibs.

To replace clause 7:

7. **Uniforms**
- 7.1 Each Club must have its Standard Regulation Uniform approved by the Management Committee.
- 7.2 The Management Committee may approve a Club's proposed Standard Regulation Uniform in its sole discretion.
- 7.3 A Player must wear the approved Standard Regulation Uniform for their Club during a Match.
- 7.4 A Player will not be permitted to play in a Match if they:
 - (a) are not wearing the approved Standard Regulation Uniform for their Club;
 - (b) are wearing gloves; or
 - (c) are wearing anything which is offensive or may negatively impact the reputation of the AMND Competition or Netball SA.
- 7.5 Players and umpires must comply with the uniform requirements in the International Netball Federation Rules of Netball (as amended from time to time). To the extent of any inconsistency between the Terms of Reference and the Rules of Netball, the Terms of Reference will apply.
- 7.6 Once a Standard Regulation Uniform has been approved by the Management Committee, the Club will not be required to apply for approval of the same Standard Regulation Uniform in subsequent years (unless on request by the Management Committee).
- 7.7 A Club may only alter its Standard Regulation Uniform with the prior approval of the Management Committee. The following conditions apply:
 - (a) the Club must submit its request to alter its Standard Regulation Uniform to the Management Committee by no later than:

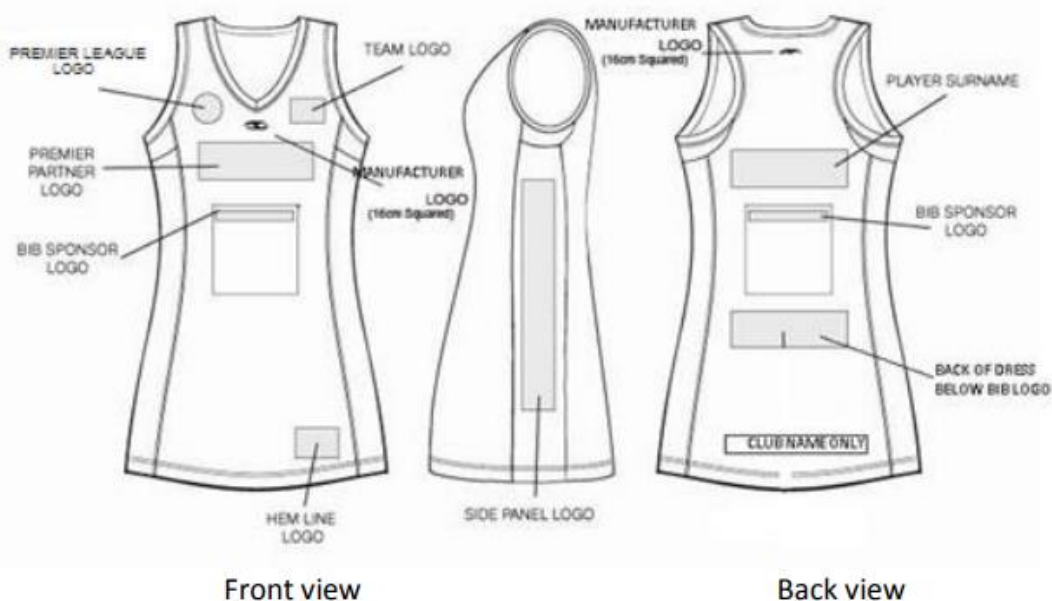
- (i) the Annual General Meeting the year prior to the year of the Competition when the Club seeks to introduce the change; or
 - (ii) such other date as approved by the Management Committee in writing; and
 - (b) the Club must submit a manufacturer's graphic of the proposed Standard Regulation Uniform.
- 7.8 Individual player names, player numbers and sponsor logos are permitted on a Standard Regulation Uniform (which may differ between Players across a Club and between Players within a Team) without the prior approval of the Management Committee in the designated spaces prescribed at Annexure A.
- 7.9 The following is permitted to be worn by a Player during a Match without prior approval from the Management Committee:
- (a) bike shorts in the Club colours or plain black or navy;
 - (b) prescription glasses; and
 - (c) headscarfs, long sleeved tops, long tights or leggings for cultural or religious reasons.
- 7.10 Where a Match involves two (2) Teams:
- (a) from the same Club; or
 - (b) with Standard Regulation Uniforms of similar colours,
- the away Team will be required to wear clash playing position bibs.
- 7.11 The Management Committee reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to amend, vary or waive any of the requirements under this clause 7, on a case by case basis, on request from a Club (which may include on grounds of cultural, religious or medical reasons).

Annexure A

Playing Uniforms

Clubs must comply with the AMND branding specifications below or the Premier League branding specifications (as amended from time to time by Netball SA) if a Club wishes to seek approval of a Standard Regulation Uniform which incorporates player names, player numbers or sponsor logos.

The same branding specifications for the dress will apply for Clubs submitting a top to be included within their Standard Regulation Uniform. Minor variations are permitted given the difference in garment dimensions.

Netball SA Premier League logo (only for Premier League Clubs)	56.25cm ² (7.5cm x 7.5cm)
Team logo	62cm ² (9.5cm x 6.5cm)
Premier Partner logo / club sponsor logo	175cm ² (25cm x 7cm)
Side panel logos	585cm ² (13cm x 45cm)
Bib sponsor logo (front and back) on dress and on bib	52cm ² (13cm x 4cm)
Back of dress, below bib logo	175cm ² (25cm x 7cm)
Hem line logo	100cm ² (10cm x 10cm)
Player name (first name or surname)	18cm x 5cm
Manufacturer logo	16cm ²
Player number (middle of shoulders on back of dress)	3cm x 3cm
Name of Club	20cm x 7cm
The branding specification is a recommended size for each position on the dress. This allows Clubs greater flexibility and will cater for a variety of sponsor logos. Drawings are not to scale.	

Playing Position Bibs

The dimensions of each bib are 19cm (h) x 22.5cm (w). The positional lettering on each bib is 15cm high. Different sponsors may be on the front and back of each bib provided the background colour of the bib and the background colour of the sponsor strip is the same. An example is illustrated below:
